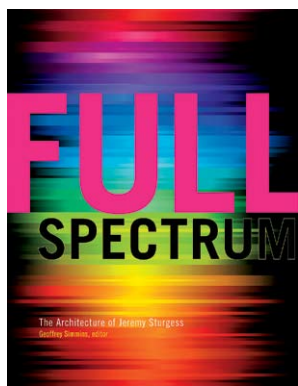


Hot Ticket

Made from a lightweight mineral composite, **MODULARARTS PANELS** are innovative sculptural mouldings that give trippy depth to any wall surface. The 32-by-32-inch interlocking panels are easy to install onto existing drywall and come in 20 contemporary designs that shift based on perspective and lighting. At just under \$200 a panel, they're both affordable and green—meaning no nasty off-gassing. —Shelora Sheldon

Putting a new spin on the recliner, **DAVID CATTÀ'S AVIATOR LOUNGE CHAIR** is a hybrid of mechanical, aeronautical and traditional design. Cattà, a designer based in Nelson, B.C., spent five years perfecting the blueprints for his lounge after finding inspiration in Herman Miller's iconic Aeron office chair. Following an advanced aero-metal workshop, Cattà opted to include materials not typically found in luxury furniture into his design: polished aluminum aluminum is hammered

(sterling silver-like finish) and a specially woven suspension fabric. The chair's overall aesthetic evokes the graceful lines of vintage aircrafts. —Susan Hollis
